Attendance Information

At St. Andrew's Primary School we want the best for our pupils and ensure attendance is always a priority. This is why we regularly remind parents and carers of the importance of good attendance at school. When a child attends school on a regular basis they take an important step towards achieving their full potential, and are given the greatest opportunity to learn new things and to develop their skills.

Rewards that are used to promote attendance:

Weekly Top Hat Prize Draw

All children who have been in school every day that week gets entered into a 100% attendance prize draw. This is to celebrate and reward good attendance. Every child has a fresh chance each week to win a prize. The 'Top Hat Winner' gets a £10 Love to Shop voucher.

Termly Class Prize

Each week on newsletter there are attendance graphs. This shows the previous week's attendance for every class in the school. The class who has the best attendance the most over that term will win the termly prize. We currently give a prize for the winning Foundation Phase class and a prize for the winning Key Stage 2 class.

Termly Certificates

A certificate and pencil is given to any pupil that has been every day that term. This way it means they have three opportunities each year to get a certificate. This is presented in an awards assembly on the last day of each term.

100% Academic Year Prize

Pupils who achieve 100% attendance for the whole academic year get a certificate and a prize. This is a huge achievement that is also discussed in our awards assembly.

We understand that there are occasions when an absence from school cannot be avoided such as a genuine illness and this is why we have a range of rewards that are done on a weekly and termly basis to ensure all children have multiple opportunities to win. Our aim is to work closely with families to ensure all pupils have the opportunity to reach for the stars and achieve their full potential.








Attendance winners - congratulations!!

Please note due to LA changes, only one day of absence will be authorised for religious observance for Eid. Anything further absence will be unauthorised and affect pupil's attendance.




Attendance Prize Winners

Technology at Home


