

# POLITE REMINDER - Parking / Dropping off and collecting children

Please could we ask that wherever possible ALL families walk to and from school. If you have to bring a vehicle, please park a few streets away from school, leaving Jenkins Street, Milner Street and Corporation Road directly outside the front of the school clear.

Please DO NOT use staff car park entrance, Milner Street gated area or resident driveways for turning cars around.

We have requested support from the Parking Enforcement Team and local Police Community support Officers – we really don't want anyone to get hurt or receive a parking fine so please be respectful.


# What is the Nurturing Progamme?
