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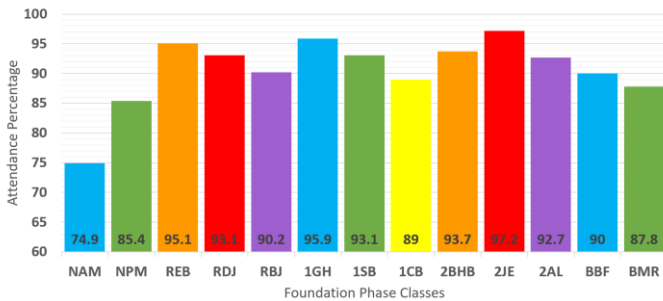

The best attendance awards for a class attendance total last week went to:

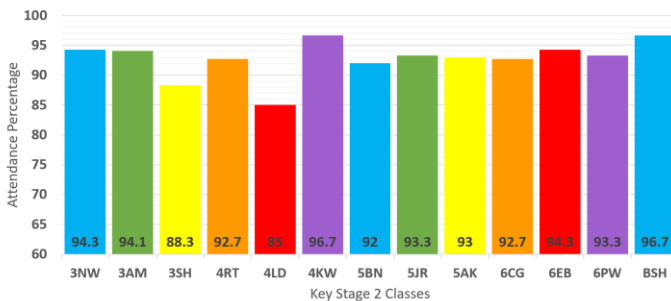
**Class 2JE in Foundation Phase with 97.2%**

## Summer School Uniform

The school has a proud tradition of school uniform and we are most grateful for the continued support of parents. At St. Andrew's Primary we aim to provide our children with a School Uniform that is FIT for Purpose and supports parents against the pressure of trying to keep up with the latest fashions.

**Please note our Summer school uniform is:**

**Black**, tailored knee-length shorts  
(boys and girls)

**White** polo shirt

**RED gingham** Summer dresses  
(not blue)

**Black** school sweatshirt or  
cardigan (with school logo if possible)

**Plain BLACK** shoes or trainers only

Please do not send your child in white shoes, coloured trainers, white cardigans or blue dresses.



## HEADLICE

Head lice are visiting the school again. Please can I ask parents to check your child's hair regularly for these visitors – in fact every time you wash your child's hair. First comb it through with a wide-tooth comb and then with a 'nit comb'. If you find any head lice contact your pharmacy / doctors for advice.

Please can you also ensure that if your child has **long hair, it is always tied back, even on NON – UNIFORM DAYS**, as this is one way to reduce the spread of headlice.
